

Mr. President of the United States.

We are the Hispanic immigrant community, the ones suffering the most under this economic crisis that everyone is currently experiencing. We can't get any of the even small amount of jobs that are available, and the worst part is that in the State of Arizona, where my family and I live, there is a law that prohibits giving work to people without legal status. We live with the fear of being caught by the Maricopa County Sheriff, of going into the streets and being arrested and then deported.

My personal situation that I am currently experiencing is that I do not have any work. The construction company I was working for closed operations and stopped giving us work. The owner of this company (Jostes Concrete, Inc.) is named Todd Jostes and he does not want to meet with us to negotiate for that money he owes us and to pay us group of 20 workers for the concrete work we did for him for many months, he owes us between \$500 and \$20,000 each.

Unfortunately we don't have a lot of influence with the legal institutions of the government, due to our legal status, to stop the abuse of this man and he continues to do work at the company. This action is him laughing at us. We need immigration reform immediately!
